

Level 6 Transitional Arrangements
October 2009 – June 2013

Scenario 1

John Smith has completed the following units:

Contract Law – October 2008
Intellectual Property – June 2009
Family Law – June 2011
Civil Litigation – January 2012

Because John has passed a level 6 unit under the Level 6 Professional Higher Diploma in Law (old qualification) and completed his final Level 6 unit under the Level 6 Professional Higher Diploma in Law and Practice (current qualification) before June 2013, he has successfully completed his Level 6 qualification.

Scenario 2

Helen Brown has completed the following units:

Land Law – October 2008
Contract Law – January 2010
Conveyancing – January 2013

Because Helen has not completed her final law unit during the transitional arrangements period, Helen will now need to complete her Level 6 qualification under the Level 6 Professional Higher Diploma in Law and Practice (current qualification) and therefore she will have to complete one law units of her choice and both the professional skills units in order to complete her level 6 qualification.

Scenario 3

Paul Jones has completed the following units:

Social Welfare Law – June 2008
Criminal Law – October 2008

Because Paul has not completed his Level 6 qualification during the transitional arrangements period, Paul will need to complete under the Level 6 Professional Higher Diploma in Law & Practice (current qualification). Because Social Welfare is no longer an accredited unit this will no longer count towards the completion of Pauls Level 6 qualification. Paul will now need to complete two further law units, 1 linked

practice unit and both professional skills (Client Care Skills and Legal Research Skills)
